SPEAKER RESPONSIBILITIES

If your speaker abstract is accepted, you agree to the Speaker Guidelines below, in which you will be given a conference discount. We are unable to offer one or two day discounts.

- Your discounted conference registration must be paid upon acceptance. You are responsible for travel and hotel.



- **ALL presentations will be live, either in person or via ZOOM through the WHOVA App.** You may submit a pre-recorded presentation for upload after your live presentation.
- You will be required to upload | **provide your PowerPoint presentation | handouts by the conference deadline in MARCH 2022 deadline.**
- ALL PowerPoints will be PDF in handout format, three to a page and uploaded to the conference materials link for download by registered conference participants.

There is no limit on the number of proposals you may submit, however, a speaker cannot present in more than 1 workshop per day.

DEADLINE for abstracts is OCTOBER 29, 2021. They will be reviewed and notifications will be sent by email in mid-NOVEMBER, 2021.

SPEAKER PROVISIONS

- We would like to keep the conference interactive both online and in person ... We will be using a hybrid method, you have the opportunity to present in person or online through the conference app www.WHOVA.com together with ZOOM for all presentations. The WHOVA app will also allow you to answer questions throughout the conference.
- Regardless of whether you present in person or online, once your abstract has been accepted you will be sent a conference link to upload your picture and bios.
